HOLTZ CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL

Holtz Children's Hospital at the University of Miami/Jackson Memorial Medical Center is among the country's elite, according to Best Children's Hospitals, published online by *U.S. News & World Report.* The rankings recognize the top 50 children's hospitals in 10 specialties.

Holtz was ranked in seven specialties this year: 25th in neonatology, 26th in nephrology, 41st in diabetes and endocrinology, 42nd in urology, 43rd in both cardiology/heart surgery and gastroenterology, and 49th in cancer.

Additionally, as part of their 2010-2011 Best Hospitals listings, U.S. News also ranked the University of Miami Health System's Bascom Palmer Eye Institute in ophthalmology and the University of Miami/Jackson Memorial Medical Center's ear, nose and throat program. Both programs support Holtz in providing child health services.
