University of Miami/Jackson Named No. 1 in South Florida

U.S. News Best Hospital Survey also Recognizes Six High-Performing Specialties at UM/Jackson and Bascom Palmer Eye Institute was ranked No. 1 for the 10th Year in a Row

The UM/Jackson Memorial Medical Center was once again named the No. 1 hospital in the Miami-Fort Lauderdale metro area by U.S. News & World Report, which also named UM/Jackson among the nation's elite with six high-performing programs.

J A C K S O N UPDATE

These rankings are considered the gold standard in recognizing hospitals that provide exceptional care in several specialties. Just three percent of the nation's nearly 5,000 hospitals earned a national ranking in at least one of the 16 specialties evaluated, and only about 15 percent were recognized for high performance.



The U.S. News & World Report Best Metro Hospital rankings evaluated 73 hospitals in the Miami-Fort Lauderdale-Palm Beach area. UM/Jackson came out on top, beating out all of its competitors.

UM/Jackson was also recognized by U.S. News & World Report's annual Best Hospitals survey, with six high performing specialties: cancer, gastroenterology and GI surgery, nephrology, neurology and neurosurgery, psychiatry and urology. UM's Bascom Palmer Eye Institute ranked No. 1 in ophthalmology for the tenth consecutive year.

These new rankings come just one month after Holtz Children's Hospital was recognized among the best in the country in U.S. News & World Report's Best Children's Hospitals rankings. Holtz ranked 22nd in gastroenterology and GI surgery, 22nd in nephrology, 32nd in neonatology, 38th in urology, 40th in cardiology and heart surgery, and 45th in diabetes and endocrinology.

The 2013-14 rankings are published online and will appear in the "Best Hospitals 2014".

Voters Decided in November on \$830 million in Bonds for Upgrades, Renovations and Improvements to Jackson Health System Facilities.

Miami-Dade taxpayers voted to approve new bonds for much-needed modernization, upgrades and renovations to Jackson facilities. The 10-year program will allow Jackson to spend \$830 million on improvements to our operating rooms and emergency departments; renovations of nearly every inpatient unit at Jackson Memorial Hospital, Jackson North Medical Center and Jackson South Community Hospital; huge amounts of deferred work to infrastructure systems like elevators and air handlers; and an estimated \$300 million in new medical equipment and other technologies. The plan also includes construction of new Jackson facilities including a completely new rehabilitation hospital on the Jackson Memorial campus, a children's ambulatory center away from the Civic Center area and as many as 10 urgent care centers that will make Jackson more accessible throughout the county for day-to-day medical needs.

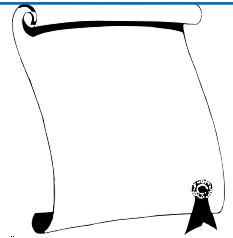

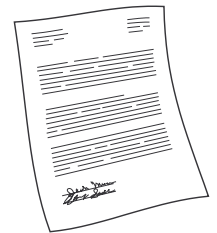
